4	Section 2.5	<p>The Arkansas 2015 School Safety Act requires that a Panic Button system must integrate with the State's pre-existing Smart911 system.</p> <p>Can the state please confirm that integration with Smart911 is a requirement as to adhere to state law?</p> <p>See Section 4.2 C in the RFQ.</p>
5	Section 2.5	<p>The current state Panic Button system enables both landline and standard mobile calls (without an app) to trigger Panic Button activity.</p> <p>Can the state please confirm that this is also a requirement of any additional Panic Button systems?</p> <p>No.</p>
6	Section 2.5	<p>The current state panic button system enables standard mobile phone calls to activate panic button activity and notifications without a phone app.</p> <p>Can the state please confirm that this is a requirement of any additional panic button systems?</p> <p>See question 5.</p>

7	Section 2.2	Do we need to register with the State of Arkansas as an LLC to be able to respond to this bid? See Section 2.2 C in the RFQ.
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
